UPON REVIEW OF THIS APPLICATION FOR A SMALL WIRELESS FACILITY PERMIT, THE FOLLOWING ARE FOUND TO BE GROUNDS FOR DENIAL:

The project interferes with the operation of traffic control equipment

The project interferes with sight lines or clear zones for transportation or pedestrians

The project fails to comply with the federal ADA or similar laws of general applicability regarding pedestrian access or movement

The project requests ground mounted small wireless facility equipment being located more than 7.5 feet in radial circumference from the base of the pole or support structure to which it is to be attached

The project fails to comply with applicable codes (i.e. Building, Fire, Erosion Control, etc.)

The project fails to comply with the maximum limitations

• Pole in ROW in a historic district and in an area primarily zoned for residential use shall not exceed 50 ft. in height above ground level

• Pole in ROW, NOT in a historic district or in an area zoned primarily for residential use shall not exceed the greater of:
 1. 50 ft. above ground level; or
 2. 10 ft. greater in height above ground level than the tallest existing structure in ROW and located within 500 ft. of new pole

• New small wireless facility in ROW shall not exceed:
 1. Collocation on existing pole or support structure- more than 10 ft. above existing
 2. Collocation on new pole, (i) and (ii)

The project interferes with the widening, repair, reconstruction, or relocation of a public road that has been advertised for bid and scheduled for completion within six (6) months after the application has been filed

The project fails to

• Comply with requirements of a historic district for collocation of small wireless facility, placement or replacement of a pole

• Certify that a proposed new pole in an area zoned for residential use

The project fails to comply with the laws of general applicability that address

• Pedestrian and Vehicular Traffic and Safety requirements

• The Occupancy or Management of the ROW and that are otherwise inconsistent with OCGA 36-66C
