ORDER APPOINTING PRESIDING JUDGE

WHEREAS the Judges of the Superior and State Courts of Cherokee County, recognizing the increasing need for alternative means of addressing the needs of veterans within the justice system, have agreed to the establishment of the Cherokee County Veterans Treatment Court (CCVTC); and

WHEREAS the Chief Judge of the Superior Court of Cherokee County is vested with the authority to appoint a Presiding Judge to act in matters pending in that Court for a period of time as determined by the Chief Judge; and

WHEREAS A. Dee. Morris, State Court Judge of Cherokee County, meets all qualifications of a Superior Court Judge as defined by O.C.G.A. §15-6-4, and has all required authority to act on behalf of the Superior Court by virtue of the need for mutual assistance pursuant to the mutual assistance order filed on November 9, 2009 in Minute Book 192, page 350.

It is hereby ORDERED as follows:

A. Dee Morris is hereby appointed as Presiding Judge of the Cherokee County Veterans Treatment Court.

While serving as Presiding Judge in any cases assigned to the Veterans Treatment Court, Judge Morris shall preside over such matters with the same authority as a Superior Court Judge.




Said appointment shall remain in effect until such further order of the Chief Judge of Superior Court.
