
**STANDING ORDER CONCERNING MANNER OF
ASSIGNMENT OF THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE STATE COURT**


Pursuant to U.S.C.R. Rule 1.2 (B), the following is hereby ordered:

The judge of the State Court of Cherokee County (hereinafter "State Court") who is most senior in length of continuous service as a State Court judge shall be designated the chief judge and shall be responsible for the administration and expeditious disposition of the business of the State Court and shall have the power to make such rules as he or she shall deem necessary or proper for such purpose but not in conflict with the general laws of this state, which rules shall be binding upon the other judges of the State Court. If two or more judges of the State Court should be equally senior in length of continuous service as State Court judges, the judges of the State Court shall at that time enter a standing order governing the assignment or election of the chief judge.
