**CHEROKEE COUNTY CLERK OF SUPERIOR COURT’S
OFFICE TO OFFER SOCIALLY DISTANT SERVICES**

Office to be closed to the public until April 13

Canton, GA—Effective Tuesday, March 24, 2020, the Cherokee County Clerk of Superior Court’s office will initiate socially distant service delivery until April 13.

The office will fulfill its constitutional mandates in a primarily virtual environment in line with the Supreme Court’s Emergency Order issued by Chief Justice Harold Melton on March 14, 2020.

Clerk of Superior Court, Patty Baker, made the decision to offer socially distant services to protect her staff and to be responsible to the greater Cherokee community.

“We want to be part of flattening the curve of COVID-19,” Baker said.

Non-emergency services, including passport applications, notary commissions, and trade names will not be available until April 13.
