STANDING ORDER


This Court finds, pursuant to Rule 25.7 of the Uniform Rules of Superior Court, applicable canons of the Code of Judicial Conduct, and Uniform State Court Rule 25.4(c), that Judge Michelle LH Homier, is disqualified from hearing any matter in any case in which Deputy Sheriff Jared W. Jordan is either a witness or arresting/citing officer for the following reasons:


The possibility exist in all cases in which the above referenced individual is listed as a witness or is the arresting/citing officer that an evidentiary hearing might be held in which Judge Michelle LH Homier might be required to rule on the credibility of this particular officer. Given said individual's previous personnel record involving Judge Michelle LH Homier, in order to ensure fair and unbiased proceedings to all parties, including Solicitor, Defendants, and all civil litigants, and to avoid the appearance of any impropriety, Judge Michelle LH Homier hereby voluntarily recuses herself.


Therefore in the interests of judicial economy, in any case initially assigned to Judge Homier where the above referenced individual is listed as a witness or is the arresting/citing officer, the case should be assigned to another Judge of Cherokee County State Court, to be selected randomly as required by Uniform State Court Rule 25.4(c), unless other standing orders of this Court are applicable, in which event those should be followed. Should the above individual later become a witness in a case originally assigned to Judge Homier, the Clerk shall, upon receipt of communication from a party, Solicitor's Office, or Judge Homier's office, randomly assign the case to another Judge or assign the case consistent with other standing orders of this Court.

This Order shall be filed with the Clerk of Court and recorded on the minutes. It may be amended by the judges of State Court as appropriate and shall remain in effect through any successions in the offices of the judges named below, so long as Judge Michelle LH Homier is a judge of this Court.
