

2. The Cherokee Office of Economic Development (formerly known as Cherokee County Development Authority), its books, sites and property and the circumstances surrounding the purchase of 53 acres at Highway 92 & James Dupree Road from Mr. Jimmy Bobo and/or his affiliated companies.
