East Cherokee Drive at Mill Creek Drive Intersection Improvements, Project 72123, Cherokee County

THE PROJECT: The Cherokee County Board of Commissioners Purchasing Department (County) is requesting competitive sealed **bids** in support of constructing the East Cherokee Drive at Mill Creek Drive Intersection Improvements, Project 73123, meeting the specifications and as described herein.

All times in the solicitation are local times to Cherokee County, Georgia in the Eastern Time Zone.

This Request for Opportunity Description is one of two documents making up this solicitation. The second document is Cherokee County Standard Solicitation Terms and Conditions, which contains all the standard forms potentially required to accompany a submission. Both of these documents together constitute the entire solicitation at the time of issuance.

The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids/proposals, to waive technicalities and to make a selection and final award as deemed to be in the best interest of the County, including using any form of contract it deems most advantageous to the County.

The base period of performance is broken down into two areas; Physical Delivery of Product(s) and Service Delivery. EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Bids/Proposals that contain options or additive work above and beyond the base bid will be evaluated financially according to the criteria described in the solicitation. However, should the use of options or additive work proposed exceed the County budget, the County retains its rights to address such situations as described in its Standard Terms For Bid and Proposal Solicitation as well as the right to award based on the base bid only or the base bid plus quoted additive work that is within its budget.

Bids determined to be Responsive and Responsible will be ranked based Bid Form Criteria.

Proposals will be scored on the above evaluation criteria. Failure to provide information necessary to evaluate proposal, may result in a lower scoring proposal.

The County reserves the right to reject the bid of any vendor who has previously failed to perform properly or complete on time contracts of a similar nature, or who upon investigation shows is not in a position to perform the contract.

The Bidder in compliance with your Notice to Contractors and all Bidding Documents for **East Cherokee Drive at Mill Creek Drive Intersection Improvements, Project 73123 – Cherokee County**, having examined the plans and specifications with related documents and the site of other proposed work, and being familiar with all of the conditions surrounding the construction of the proposed project, including the availability of materials and supplies to construct the project in accordance with the contract documents, within the time set forth herein, and at the prices stated below, proposes to enter into a Contract, on the form provided by Cherokee County, with Cherokee County to provide the necessary machinery, tools, apparatus, all materials and labor, and other means of construction necessary to complete the Work. The undersigned proposes to furnish and construct the items listed in the attached Schedule of Items for the unit prices stated.

Bidder agrees that the cost of any work performed, materials furnished, services provided or expenses incurred, which are not specifically delineated in the Contract Documents, but which are incidental to the scope, the intent, and completion of the Contract, shall be deemed to have been included in the price bid for the various items scheduled.

Bidder agrees to provide payment and performance bonds on the forms provided by Cherokee County and in conformance with applicable Georgia law. Any such bonds shall be subject to review and approval of the County Attorney.

Bidder, if successful, prior to commencement of the work shall execute a written oath as required by O.C.G.A. §§ 32-4-122 and 36-91-21(e).

Bidder further proposes and agrees hereby to promptly commence the Work with adequate force and equipment with seven (7) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed, or as may be specified by Special Provision, and to complete the Work as specified by the schedule.

The undersigned Bidder further agrees that in case of failure on his part to execute said contract and bonds, or provide satisfactory proof of carriage of the insurance required, within fourteen (14) calendar days after notification of award thereof, the Bid Bond or certified check accompanying his

bid and the money payable hereon shall be forfeited to the County not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages because actual damages would be difficult or impossible to determine; otherwise, the check or Bond accompanying this proposal shall be returned to the Bidder.

The Bidder declares that he understands that the quantities shown on the proposal are subject to adjustment by either increase or decrease, and that should the quantities of any of the items of work be increased, the undersigned proposes to do the additional work at the unit prices stated herein; and should the quantities be decreased, he also understands that payment will be made on actual quantities at the unit price bid and will make no claim for anticipated profits for any decrease in the quantities, and that actual quantities will be determined upon completion of work, at which time adjustment will be made to the Contract amount by the direct increase or decrease.

PROJECT SPECIFICS

1. The Contractor shall not perform work or move equipment or materials across any roadway and interfere with traffic flow on the main roads or local streets between the hours of 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, unless approved by the Engineer. Equipment or materials moved on or across the roadway at other times shall be done in a manner so as minimize interference with traffic.
2. If night work is necessary to perform project work, a written request shall be submitted to Cherokee County and approved at least three days in advance. Working hours for night work are between 8:00 PM and 6:00 AM, Monday through Friday, unless approved by the Engineer.
3. Construction signs need to be mounted.
4. Contractor shall use reduced speed limit signs per GDOT 150 to be included in cost for traffic control.
5. Temporary striping costs to be included in Traffic Control pay item. Roads should be striped as soon as possible after paving.
6. Contractor shall construct the project following Georgia Department of Transportation current standards and specifications manual, supplemental specifications, and construction standards and details.
7. Contractor shall ensure that the roundabout is illuminated prior to transitioning traffic to the new pattern. If contractor's phasing does not enable the use of proposed permanent lighting for this purpose, then the contractor shall provide temporary intersection lighting at no additional cost to Cherokee County. Any temporary lighting costs shall be incidental to pay item 150-1000 traffic control.
8. Roundabouts with landscaping in the middle: Contractor shall install conduit extending into middle of roundabout sufficient enough to install future water irrigation. Price for conduit will be included in bid for grading complete.
9. There will be a 14-day cure on final lift of asphalt prior to placement of thermoplastic striping.
10. All pipe shall be reinforced concrete pipe (RCP).
11. If any additional pay items not included in the contract are deemed necessary by the Engineer, then the contractor shall negotiate a price with the County for the additional pay item. Price shall be not more than 10% greater than the current GDOT item mean price for that pay item.

12. Contractor is responsible for utility coordination and ensuring that the location of all utilities is accurate to the best of their knowledge.
13. Any detour requests must be submitted 21 days prior to road closure for review and approval.
14. Any irrigation lines cut shall be capped and flag to back of ROW.
15. Power utility bills for signals and roundabout lighting will be the contractor's responsibility until the project is final accepted.
16. Contractor shall coordinate with the Deer Valley Parkway development project and will maintain access to their development at all times.
17. Water and sewer installation shown on the plans will be installed by the Deer Valley development project.
