REQUEST FOR BIDS

RFB# 2023-016: 2023 Resurfacing Project, Project No. 75708

THE PROJECT: The Cherokee County Board of Commissioners Purchasing Department (County) is requesting competitive sealed **bids** in support of the 2023 Roadway Resurfacing Project, Project No. 75708 to resurface 13.67 miles of roadway, meeting the specifications and as described herein.

There **will not** be a mandatory meeting to review the requirements.

All times in the solicitation are local times to Cherokee County, Georgia in the Eastern Time Zone.

This Request for Opportunity Description is one of two documents making up this solicitation. The second document is Cherokee County Standard Solicitation Terms and Conditions, which contains all the standard forms potentially required to accompany a submission. Both of these documents together constitute the entire solicitation at the time of issuance.

The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids/proposals, to waive technicalities and to make a selection and final award as deemed to be in the best interest of the County, including using any form of contract it deems most advantageous to the County.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Bids/Proposals that contain options or additive work above and beyond the base bid will be evaluated financially according to the criteria described in the solicitation. However, should the use of options or additive work proposed exceed the County budget, the County retains its rights to address such situations as described in its Standard Terms For Bid and Proposal Solicitation as well as the right to award based on the base bid only or the base bid plus quoted additive work that is within its budget.

STATEMENT OF WORK AND / OR SPECIFICATION:

The Cherokee County Roadway Capital Program Management Division is requesting bids for the following project:

2023 Resurfacing Project, Project No. 75708 to resurface 13.67 miles of roads and streets in Cherokee County, as per current Georgia DOT Standards and Specifications.

Contract Time: 120 Calendar days, Proposal Guarantee: 5%

Bidders must be unconditionally qualified prospective bidders in accordance with Chapter 672-5 of the Rules of the Georgia Department of Transportation.

The work to be done consists of the furnishing of all material, labor and equipment for this project. All work performed for this project will be in accordance with Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Construction of Roads and Bridges, latest edition. Liquidated Damages assessed as per section 108.08 of the Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications.

PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS:

1. Contractor shall not perform work or move equipment or materials on the roadway that interferes with traffic flow on the mainline or local streets between the hours of 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, unless approved by the Engineer. Equipment or materials moved on or across the roadway at all other times shall be done in a manner as not to interfere with traffic.
2. All quantities are estimated and will be field verified.
3. Contractor's equipment shall not be parked in any adjacent subdivision amenity areas or on residents' right-of-way without first obtaining permission from the homeowner's association.
4. Utilities:
 - a. It is Contractor's responsibility for coordination of utilities.
 - b. Contact Cherokee County Water and Sewage Authority representative for water valve adjustments. Materials will be provided. Adjustments will be Contractor's responsibility during paving.
5. Paving:
 - a. Transition joints for overlay areas shall be at least 50 feet long for a smooth transition.
 - b. All roads to be free of debris prior to paving.
 - c. All patching must be covered the same day.
 - d. Contractor may encounter subgrade in milling.
 - e. Trackless tack is required.
 - f. Any locations that are mill and inlay must be milled and paved in the same day.

6. Signs:
 - a. Day use signs shall be used.
 - b. Furnish neighborhood information signs at the entrance to neighborhoods. Information to include: approximate dates for paving, no on-street parking, no waste containers in the road, etc. at least 7 days prior to start of paving.
7. Striping:
 - a. Temporary striping costs to be included in Traffic Control pay item. Roads should be striped as soon as possible.
 - b. 15-day cure on final lift of asphalt prior to placement of Thermoplastic Striping.
8. Miscellaneous:
 - a. Manhole adjustment pay item to be field verified with a Cherokee County representative prior to paving by marking on gutter, etc. Not all manholes need to be adjusted. Manholes to be adjusted during paving. Details show quantity of all manholes.

Shoulder reconstruction required as per GDOT Specification 216 – Unpaved Shoulders and Construction Details, P-7 “Pavement Edge Treatment Asphalt and Concrete Pavement”. Pay Item 210-0200 - Grading per Shoulder Mile, includes compaction and permanent grassing of these shoulders. Hydro-seed is acceptable. Expect an average shoulder width of 4 feet. Must begin shoulder work within 14 days of final lift of asphalt. Shoulder building pay item is inclusive of both sides of the street.

The Bidder in compliance with your Notice to Contractors and all Bidding Documents for the **2023 Resurfacing Project, Project No. 75708 to resurface 13.67 miles of roads and streets in Cherokee County**, project, having examined the plans and specifications with related documents and the site of other proposed work, and being familiar with all of the conditions surrounding the construction of the proposed project, including the availability of materials and supplies to construct the project in accordance with the contract documents, within the time set forth herein, and at the prices stated below, proposes to enter into a Contract, on the form provided by Cherokee County, with Cherokee County to provide the necessary machinery, tools, apparatus, all materials and labor, and other means of construction necessary to complete the Work. The undersigned proposes to furnish and construct the items listed in the attached Schedule of Items for the unit prices stated.

Bidder agrees that the cost of any work performed, materials furnished, services provided or expenses incurred, which are not specifically delineated in the Contract Documents, but which are incidental to the scope, the intent, and completion of the Contract, shall be deemed to have been included in the price bid for the various items scheduled.

Bidder agrees to provide payment and performance bonds on the forms provided by Cherokee County and in conformance with applicable Georgia law. Any such bonds shall be subject to review and approval of the County Attorney.

Bidder, if successful, prior to commencement of the work shall execute a written oath as required by O.C.G.A. §§ 32-4-122 and 36-91-21(e).

Bidder further proposes and agrees hereby to promptly commence the Work with adequate force and equipment with seven (7) calendar days from receipt of Notice to Proceed, or as may be specified by Special Provision, and to complete the Work as specified by the schedule in Special Provision Section 108-08 of the Georgia Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, latest edition.

The undersigned Bidder further agrees that in case of failure on his part to execute said contract and bonds, or provide satisfactory proof of carriage of the insurance required, within fourteen (14) calendar days after notification of award thereof, the Bid Bond or certified check accompanying his bid and the money payable hereon shall be forfeited to the County not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages because actual damages would be difficult or impossible to determine; otherwise, the check

or Bond accompanying this proposal shall be returned to the Bidder.

The Bidder declares that he understands that the quantities shown on the proposal are subject to adjustment by either increase or decrease, and that should the quantities of any of the items of work be increased, the undersigned proposes to do the additional work at the unit prices stated herein; and should the quantities be decreased, he also understands that payment will be made on actual quantities at the unit price bid and will make no claim for anticipated profits for any decrease in the quantities, and that actual quantities will be determined upon completion of work, at which time adjustment will be made to the Contract amount by the direct increase or decrease.
