



Cherokee County Resolution & Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States of America, the guardian of our liberties, embodies the principles of limited government in a Republic dedicated to the rule by law; and

WHEREAS, September 17, 2021 marks the 234th anniversary of the signing of the Constitution of the United States of America at the 1787 Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, every anniversary of the Constitution provides an historic opportunity for all Americans to learn about the rights and privileges of citizenship and Georgia's historic role during our nation's founding; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this document and its memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic celebrations which commemorate it; and

WHEREAS, Georgia Senate Resolution #529 calls for the "Magnificent Seven" influence sectors - Business, Law Enforcement, Government, Religion, Education, Media and Service Organizations, to join together in using the U.S. Constitution to defeat Civic Illiteracy and protect the next generation of America's youth; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Cherokee County Commissioners:
